

Her first series, *The Secret Life of Scoundrels*, was contracted to Grand Central/Forever in 2014, and her debut novel, *Dukes are Forever*, set for release in November, 2015 (with *Along Came a Rogue* in February, 2016 and *How I Married a Marquess* in May, 2016).

The best part of writing historical romances for Anna is falling into history—to live in the world of Regency England through her characters, with dazzling balls, beautiful dresses, and gorgeous estates that she would otherwise never be able to experience. She loves the period's history, especially the architecture, and finds that all those rules of proper etiquette and propriety can be worked to the heroine's advantage...if she's daring enough to seize her dreams.

Anna adores all things chocolate, dives into ice cream of any flavor, and guzzles Kona coffee by the gallon.
